

FAST FACTS FOR RIDING THE SCHOOL BUS

Register for the Bus... School bussing <u>is not</u> automatically set up when registering your students for school.

Please check eligibility and register for the bus on our website www.nwobus.ca. You can also contact our office, no later than mid-August, to ensure arrangements are in

place for your child's first day of school.

First Rider Program... All new riders from JK to Grade 3 are encouraged to participate in our 'First Rider'

school bus safety training program. This program teaches bus safety and may provide an opportunity for students to experience a bus ride. Watch our website or contact

our office for more information.

Visible Parent Program... In the interest of safety, all Kindergarten (JK & SK) students must be accompanied to

and from the school bus every day. This can be a parent/guardian, or responsible

person who is at least 11 years old or in grade 6.

Special Needs... Please let us know if your student has special needs that may require accommodation

for transportation. Providing this information will enable us to care more

appropriately for your child.

Life-Threatening Medical

Conditions...

Please let us know if your child has any type of potentially life-threatening medical condition such as severe allergy, diabetes, heart condition, etc. This information will remain confidential and is provided to Bus Drivers so they will understand what is

happening and what action to take in the event of an emergency.

No Food and Drink on the

Bus...

Eating or drinking is not permitted on the school bus due to the risk of choking, presence of possible food allergies and to keep the bus clean for all students.

Cancellations or delays...

Bus delays and cancellations can happen throughout the school year due to weather, road conditions, facility closures, or other unforeseen circumstances. Late buses and cancellations are posted on www.nwobus.ca and on our Facebook page. We encourage all families to sign up for our text message and email alerts to be notified about bus service interruptions in your community.

Emergency Evacuation Drills...

Emergency Bus Evacuation Drills' take place twice a year, once in the fall and again in the spring. These drills are conducted as a surprise, much like a fire drill, at a preapproved location. Every student has a role to play, from the drivers' helpers to the little ones learning to exit the bus in a calm, organized manner.

Requirement to ride...

In order to maintain a spot on the school bus, students must use the bus as their primary mode of transportation (at least half the time).

Parent Portal...

The NWOSSC Parent Portal gives you instant access to your child's bussing information from JK to Grade 12! Create your account, then in September ask your school for your child's Ontario Education Number (OEN) to add your child to the account.
