ANNUAL REQUEST FOR SHARED CUSTODY ARRANGEMENTS
(JK – GRADE 6)

Transportation Policy Section 7.0 Shared Custody
Transportation may be considered in situations where parents have shared custody as court ordered.

- Custodial Parents/Guardians must choose a Primary and Secondary transportation address;
- Both addresses must be eligible for transportation based on the Consortium Transportation Policy, and no route deviations or extensions will be granted. There must be room on the bus servicing the Secondary address;
- The p.m. drop-off location must be the same every school day, regardless of which parent the child is with. This may be based on either the Primary or Secondary address;
- On a daily basis, the student can utilize the a.m. pick-up location based on either the Primary or Secondary address. Parents/guardians are responsible for managing safety and communication and must ensure school administration has an accurate and up to date schedule.

Note: Where the parents cannot agree to the drop-off location, the parent with the greater share custody (as per court documents) will determine the drop off location. If the situation involves a 50% joint custody situation, the parents must agree on the drop off location, otherwise transportation will not be provided to either parent.
