Subject: Sioux North High School/Queen Elizabeth District High School 2018-2019

In response to increasing school bus ridership, an ongoing local bus driver shortage, and to be prepared for the opening of Sioux North High School, the Consortium has made some changes to the school bus system for the 2018-2019 school year. These changes are reflected in the bussing information that students and families have received in preparation for the new school year.

KPDSB has announced that the new Sioux North High School building will **not** be open for the first day of school on September 5, 2018. New school bus routing will still be implemented as planned, however school bus service for high school students will be provided to/from Queen Elizabeth District High School until the transition to the new school building is complete. You will receive further communication from KPDSB in the fall about the transition.

Please be assured that pickup and drop off times sent by mail or electronically to all students in the Sioux Lookout area are still applicable. As always, we require that students/parents arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes before the scheduled time for the month of September, and 5 minutes early for the remainder of the school year to make sure that you don't miss the bus.
